What is Community Choice Aggregation?

Community Choice Aggregation (CCA), also known as Community Power in New Hampshire, is a program that allows cities and towns to purchase electricity on behalf of their residents and businesses. While the utility still handles delivery and billing, the municipality chooses the power supplier. This gives communities:

- ✓ <u>Energy Independence:</u> CCA allows NH residents to exercise increased oversight over their electricity expenses and energy sources, while decreasing dependence on traditional utility supply.
- ✓ <u>Affordability Benefits:</u> CCA offers opportunities for more affordable energy rates through collective purchasing power and local decision-making.
- ✓ <u>Support for Sustainability Goals:</u> NH communities can choose to adopt renewable energy alternatives in support of their own objectives.
- ✓ <u>Community Empowerment:</u> CCA empowers communities and allows residents to shape their own energy future with informed choices and collaboration.
